How does an iEARN Online course work?

Each course is asynchronous. This means you work in your own time from home or school to complete weekly assignments. However, iEARN courses are very interactive and communication with other course members and facilitators is continuous throughout the course period. Each course has 25 participants and two facilitators. You will communicate with one another through the iEARN discussion forums to discuss assignment and readings. You can expect frequent feedback from your facilitators and participants throughout the course period.
